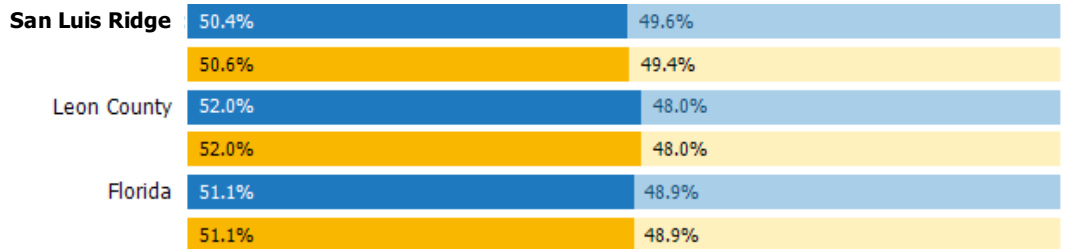

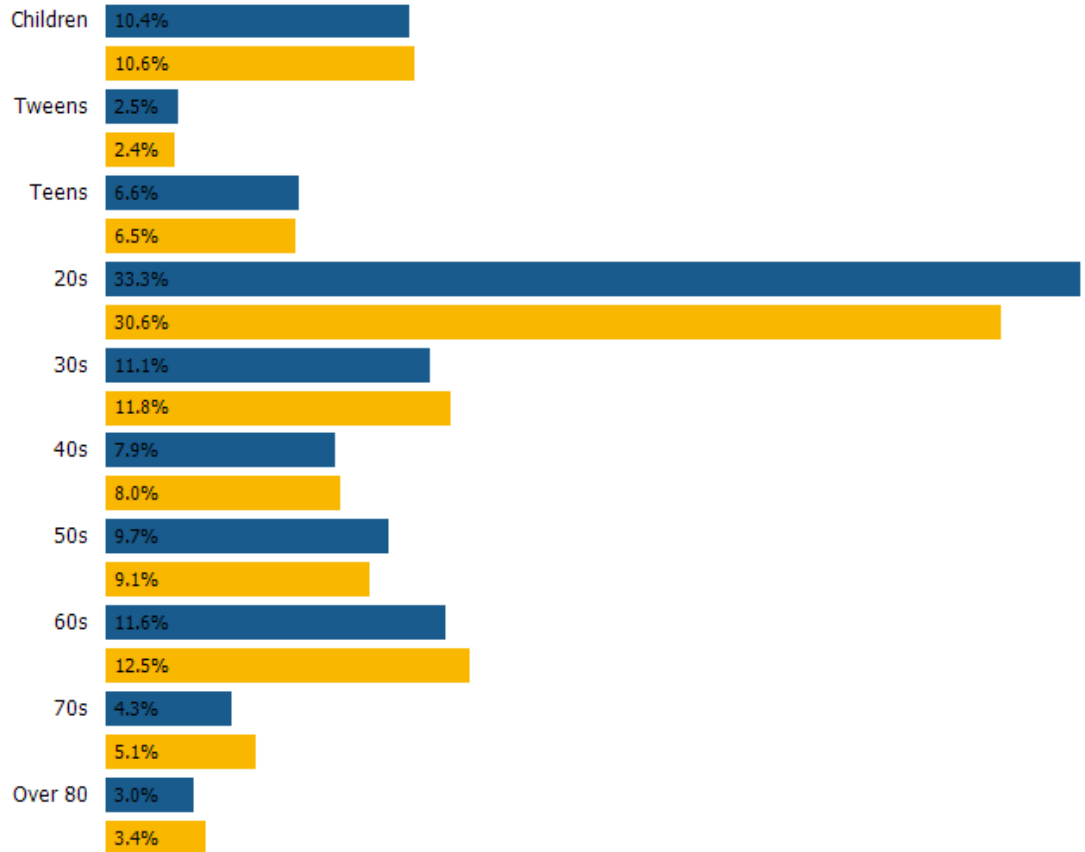
Population by Age

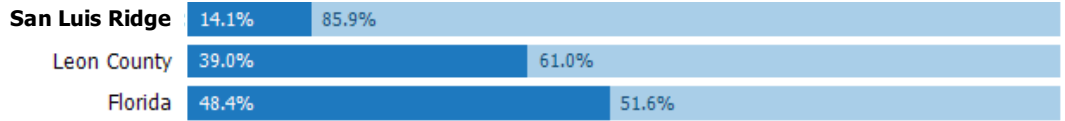

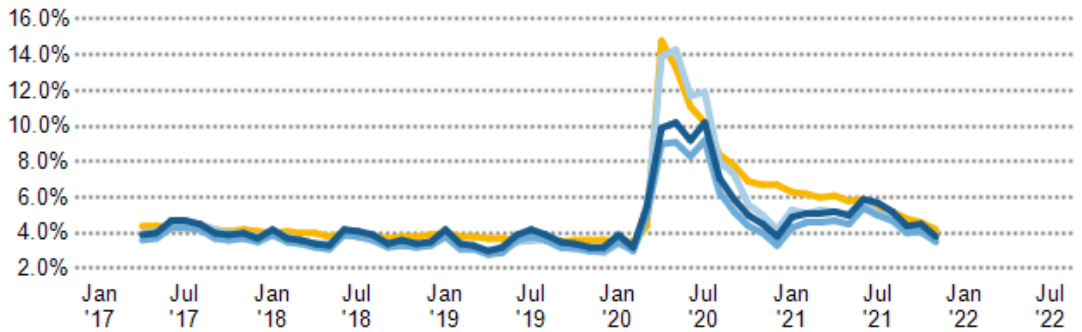
Unemployment Rate

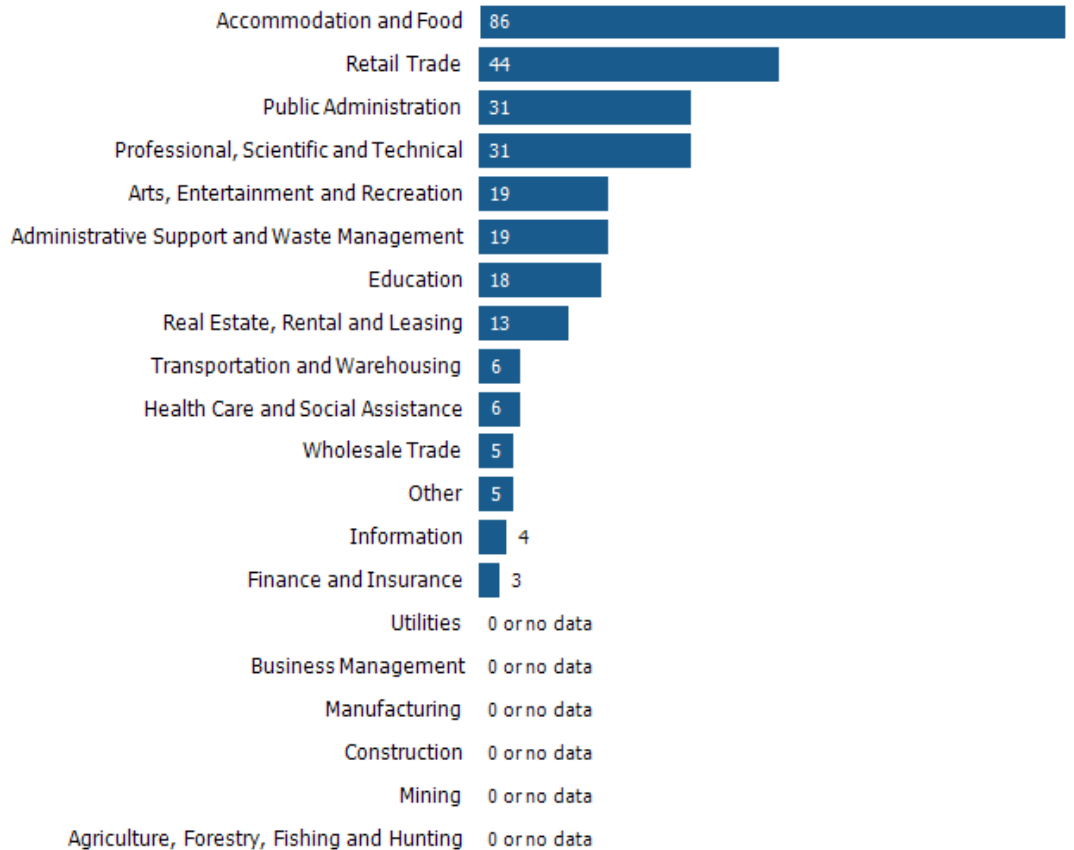


Employment Count by Industry

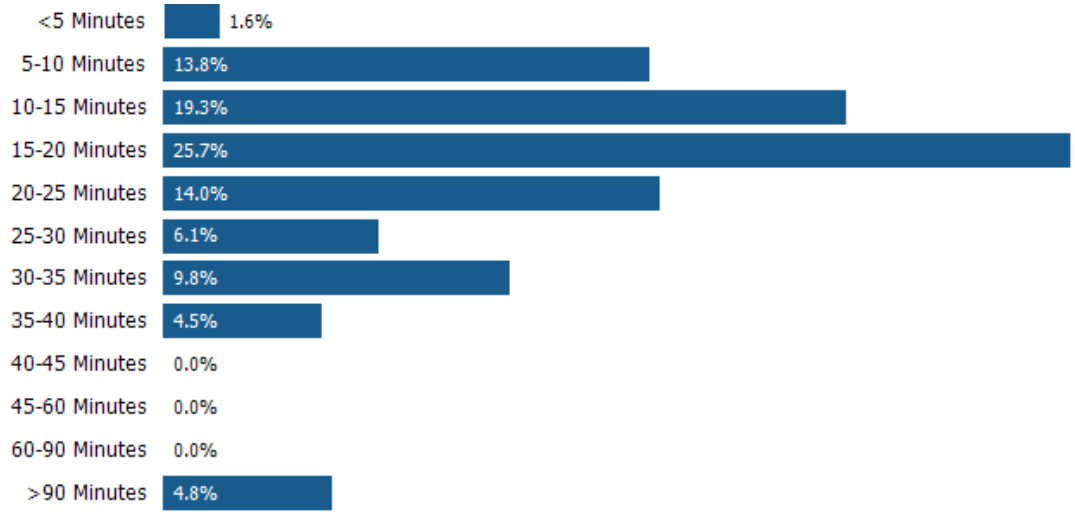

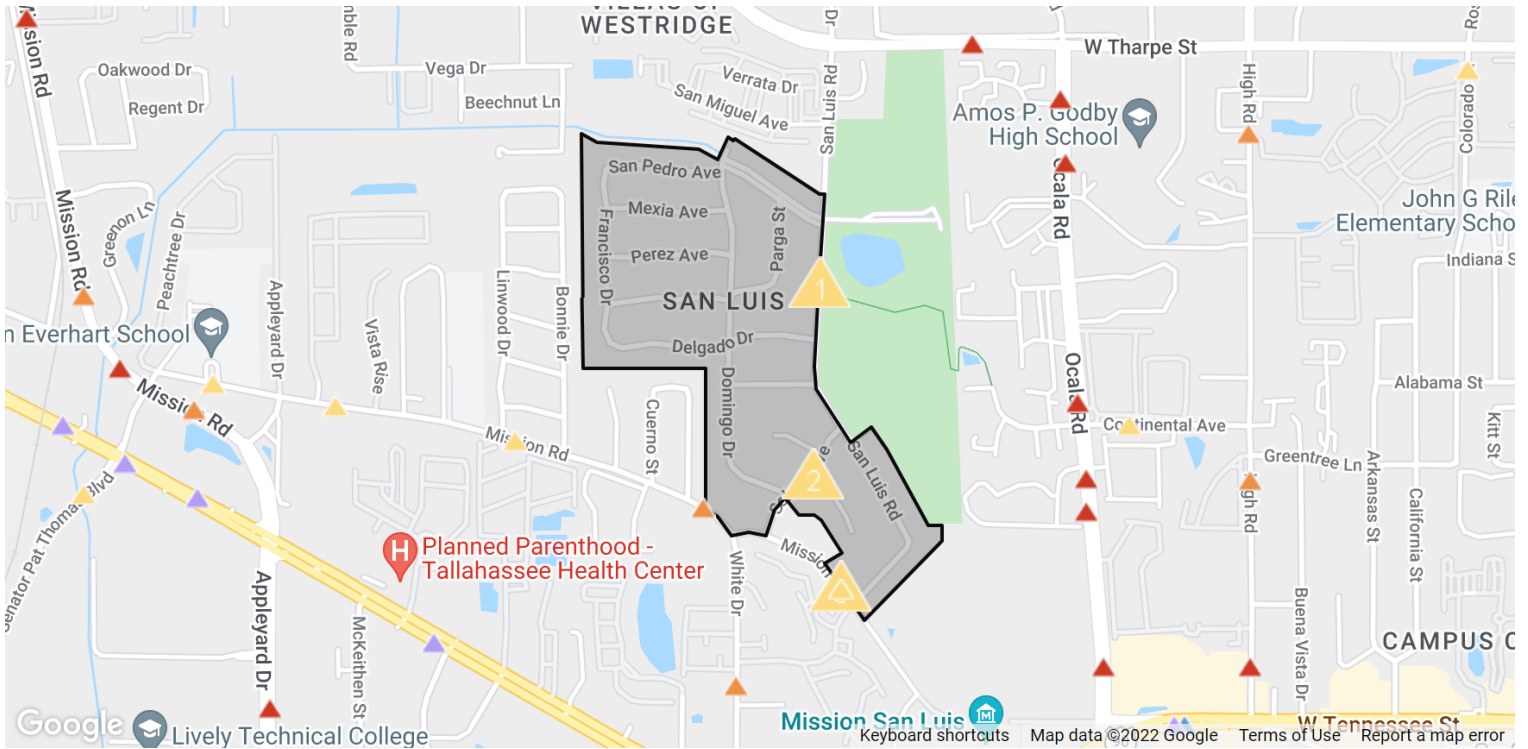
